



SHAWNEE PEAK SKI/RIDE PROGRAM (Grades 3 - 8)

Due to overwhelming demand, we will be offering the Shawnee Peak Ski Program this year, however there will be additional precautions and adjustments to the program.

We are **ONLY** taking two buses this year accommodating a total of 44 to 50 students (siblings will be asked to sit together). Parent chaperones are needed for this program. Masks will be worn on the bus at all times, unless children are eating or hydrating.

Trips will be on Wednesdays (remote learning day). Buses will leave from the rear parking lot of the Community Center at 12:00 pm and return by 7:00 pm. **This will allow for almost four hours of ski/ride time.**

Lessons (1 hour) will be offered for all participants, those in 3 - 5 grade must take lessons. Free skiing and riding will be available for those in 6 - 8 grade.

Ski Levels:

1. First time skier
2. Skied a few times with no formal instruction
3. Wedge turns on easy terrain, controls speed with shape of turns
4. Matches skis at the end of turns
5. Finishes turns with parallel skis
6. Open track parallel uses edges and pressure in turns
7. Parallel skis at all times, rhythm & movement in turns
8. Aggressive carved turns, able to control speed on any terrain

3. Fairly proficient snowboarder
