

The Spurwink Church



Available for public use May 1 through October 31, the church may be reserved by calling Cape Elizabeth Community Services at (207) 799-2868 or visiting their website at <u>www.capecommunityservices.org</u>.



The center aisle is 33" wide and 38'in length.



The chandelier, which hangs in the middle over the center aisle, is the only source of light within the church. In November 1895, the original chandelier fell and broke into pieces almost setting the church on fire. In those days the chandelier illuminated the church by candlelight. The present chandelier was purchased second hand. It was originally cast around 1850. It burned kerosene until electrified and refinished in 1982.

Parking for events shall be in the designated parking lot. The grass-covered lot is located across the street from the church. Depending on the number of anticipated vehicles, the renter may want to arrange for a parking attendant to ensure maximum use of the lot. The parking lot will accommodate three lines of parking; along the front and back of the lot and one line in the middle.
