

The (rescheduled) 42th Annual Mid-Winter 10 Mile Classic Road Race 9:45 a.m., Sunday, March 1, 2026

Racers and volunteers arrive at Cape Elizabeth High School (CEHS) as early as 7:00 a.m. The race finishes at about noon. Due to the race, there will be increased traffic and traffic delays in Cape Elizabeth and Scarborough on Sunday morning. This all-volunteer non-profit race is organized by the Maine Track Club and donates \$15,000 annually to youth running in Maine.

Race Route

Start at CE High School → Route 77/Ocean House Road → Scott Dyer Road → Spurwink Avenue → Eastman Road → Sawyer Road → Bowery Beach Road → Finish at CE High School

Approximate times & locations of delays and closures are:

Route 77/Ocean House Road: 9:45 am -10:00 am (from CE HS to Scott Dyer Rd.)

Scott Dyer Road: 9:45 am -10:15 am Spurwink Avenue: 9:50 am -10:45 am

PARKING

(for runners, volunteers, spectators, and people using the CEHS Pool)

The mid and lower level parking lots will be restricted for the race from 6:30 am - 1 pm. We recommend if you'd like to leave during that time, that you park in the upper lots noted in green below. Volunteers will help you exit safely while runners are finishing (10:30 am - 12:00 pm).
